### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This wine was made with Pinot Noir grapes sourced from Flaherty Vineyard in Naramata. During fermentation, pump-overs were used to ensure it was not over extracted. This enhanced the fruit characteristics in the wine and created a beautiful tannin structure. To allow the fruit in this wine to age gently, our winemaker carefully selected mostly neutral French oak barrels to age the wine for 9 months. It was further bottle-aged for 12 months before release.

### TASTING NOTES

Savour notes of sweet red fruit, red cherries, and bright summer strawberries. As this wine opens up, enjoy this medium-bodied wine with fresh acidity, a lingering back palate, and a long finish. During its youth, the wine will benefit from decanting prior to serving.
